- The 2nd annual Toronto Freedom Festival (TFF) was born out of the responsible activism of The Global Marijuana March, which has been happening the first Saturday of May for the last 10 years with fantastic results
- Since its inception, not one person has ever been arrested for possession at Toronto's Global Marijuana March, nor have there been any incidents of violence
- With 200 cities participating worldwide, Toronto's Global Marijuana March had the largest attendance for 2007 with over 12,000 marchers
- TFF's Expected attendance is over 25,000 participants
- Over 25 musical acts and 50+ food and retail vendors present
- TFF will be a wheel-chair accessible event
- TFF is a free celebration of our cherished freedoms and innovations.
